6.1 Consideration of Refunding 2013 Revenue Bonds

Jim Young & Lindsey Rea provided the Board with the options the District has in refunding the 2013 Revenue Bonds. If the presented commitment letter is signed by the District, total debt service savings will be realized in the amount of \$927,577, with the potential for more savings if the debt converts to tax exempt bonds at some point in the future. This will be in excess of the minimum savings required by law to refund such debt. At this time the team doesn't know if the District will qualify for a conversion to tax exempt bonds once the other obligations are paid off. The Board Attorney stated that if the Board determined this action was in the best interests of the District, the Board should authorize the General Manager to execute the commitment letter in order to move forward with the bond refunding.

Mr. Bannister made a motion, seconded by Mr. Westfall, authorizing the General Manager to execute the commitment letter subject to the stipulations specified in the resolution. Motion passed unanimously.
