ÖRDER APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF CERTAIN EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH CONTINUITY OF SYSTEM OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, on or about April, 2022, the General Manager was put on notice of a potential emergency situation relating to a severe global supply chain crisis; and

WHEREAS, certain critical items such as grinder pumps will likely be unavailable in the immediate future due to this crisis; and

WHEREAS, Section 31-7-13(k) of the Mississippi Code allows a governing authority to waive bid requirements where, as here, it is faced with emergency situations that are injurious to the citizens or their property due to the impending failure of public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager solicited written quotes from suppliers (See Exhibit "A"); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has issued purchase orders for such equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that, due to the critical nature of the equipment which will soon become unavailable, the delay incident to giving opportunity for competitive bidding would have been detrimental to the interests of the District.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Commissioners of West Jackson County Utility District, that the emergency purchases described herein are hereby approved and authorized.
